"I am searching my unconscious for surrealistic images."

I shall compare my work with the labor of a diamond miner, who must search through tons of rubble to find only one precious stone. The value of his find, however, is not known until the stone has been cut. I am searching my unconscious for surrealistic images.

Surrealistic art is difficult to create because it is paradoxical. Salvador Dali's painting of the dissolving watches, for example, is unforgettable because it goes against our underlying assumptions about nature. My metaphysical photographs show the unexpected. My images are created so we can escape from the laws of nature for at least a moment. In every respect they are paradoxical and are in contradiction to reality. Each side contains a hidden key to the other.
